
Day 1: Captain Claud will pick up guests and return to Askari to depart for Moorea, 2.5 hours away. We will anchor in beautiful Cooks Bay for lunch and then depart on a quad bike adventure tour of the island.







Day 2: After breakfast, guests take a guided hiking tour up one of Moorea's most pituresque valleys at the foot of Mou'a Puta. This tour includes a tropical fruit tasting, feeding eels in the river and a swim beneath a waterfall. Back onboard for lunch and watersports or an intro dive during the afternoon.



Day 3: A chance to go fishing with a local fisherman or an intro dive this morning. Lunch on Askari, then a tender ride to a motu for snorkelling with black tip reef sharks and stingrays. We will up anchor and head for Huahine at around 20h00, arriving around 08h00 the next day.







Day 4 - Anchor in Bourayne Bay, guests enjoy breakfast followed by a snorkel at the nearby motu (small island). Either an intro dive or a tender drive to the bridge joining Huahine Iti to Huahine Nui.


At 12:00 guests head ashore for a private beach picnic, Tahitian games, sports, Pareo tying lessons and more. A sunset cocktail onboard to finish the day.







Day 5: After breakfast, we up anchor and head for Raiatea. Here we stop for either a river tour by kayak or paddle board, or a wreck dive of the "Nordby". We then continue to an anchorage on the southern coast of Taha'a.



Day 6: Moving through the lagoon, guests breakfast underway to one of our favourite snorkelling spots. A drift snorkel with amazing coral and fish life. After lunch, we head to Bora Bora in time for some water sports until the sunset.



Day 7: After breakfast, a tender ride to snorkel at the aquarium or go outside the lagoon to snorkel with Lemon sharks. During lunch, Askari will move to the airport anchorage where we might have time to snorkel with Manta rays before guest departure.
